

# Italian Overview – Term 3, 2021



## **H22, H23 & M4 – Reception & R/1**

Students will be learning the names for fruits and vegetables in Italian and building on their knowledge of colours. They will learn how to say what they like and dislike to eat, comparing the foods they eat to what children and people in Italy eat.

## **M1 – JP Special Needs Class**

Children will listen to stories and songs spoken in Italian – in particular the ‘ciao’ song and ‘mangia, mangia!’. These texts will support their learning and adjustment to the school routine.

## **M3 & M3a – Years 1/2**

As a class we will be discussing what food we like to eat and how these foods are different or the same to the types of food that Italian children like and dislike to eat. Students will have a close look at the names of familiar foods in Italian.

## **M8, M7, R12 & C19 – Years 2/3, 3/4 & 4/5**

This term students will be having a close look at some of the traditional Italian food dishes and food culture in Italy. They will learn how to purchase different types and quantities of food in an Italian market and as well as how to communicate what food they like or dislike. As a class we will practise using this language in role play scenarios.

## **R15 – Primary Special Needs Class**

R15 will be thinking and talking a lot about food in our lessons this term! We will learn how to say some of the fruits and vegetables in Italian. Students will also learn how to say what they like and dislike to eat and how to respond politely to questions related to their food preferences.

## **C20, R17 & R13 – Years 5/6 & 6/7**

This term, students will be learning about some traditional Italian dishes and what cities they come from. They will then look at what a typical Italian restaurant menu looks like from a region of their choice and create their own menus written in Italian, using canva.
