We will be studying the following topics this term;

Literacy

- Information Report Examine the purpose and structure of information reports. Build vocabulary around procedures. Our focus will be on developing vocabulary around celebrations. We will be learning different ways to present work eg posters, slideshow
- Recount We will be reviewing recounts and focussing on using the past tense and descriptive writing.
- Word Study The word study program we are using has been developed by Words
 Their Way; a word study program, which allows teachers to provide differentiated, and
 effective instruction in phonics, spelling, and vocabulary.
- Oral Language-Students will prepare and present a talk, each week, on various topics.
 The timetable and list of topics will be in each student's homework book. It will start in week 3.
